INDIA COVID RELEIF FUND (ICRF)



In the last 2 years the whole world experienced the suffering of the COVID-19 pandemic. The unnumbered deaths of people devastated the whole medical system throughout the world. Every country went on the complete lockdown to survive. But economical breakdown taught us that "Nationwide lockdown" will not be the solution. Experts from all over the world agreed to Universal vaccination will be the best solution to the deadliness of the pandemic. Like other countries, the government of India arranged several vaccination drives. But especially in rural areas, those drives remained unsuccessful. The same scenario continued in Jharkhand. The rural people mainly the tribals believe in myths and they rejected the vaccination drives straightaway due to the occurrence of traditional taboos. SUPPORT in collaboration with Give India conducted mass awareness drives in 2 blocks of Hazaribagh district namely Churchu and Dadi, and 1 block of Ramgarh district namely Mandu to facilitate the vaccination process in collaboration with the Government. SUPPORT is accredited as Mother NGO of Hazaribagh District by Gov. of Jharkhand to combat COVID-19.

INTEGRATED DRINKING WATER PROJECT IN PARTNERSHIP WITH JAL JEEVAN MISSION AT CHURCHU BLOCK OF HAZARIBAGH DISTRICT, JHARKHAND

Under the flagship program 'Jal Jeevan Mission' by government of India/ Jharkhand; SUPPORT & CInI nurtured community leaders and trained cadres from the community as representatives are working to bring out rich learning on what needs to be done next, to amplify this impact such that large-scale change can be brought about. In this mission program, we are working in 41 villages of Churchu block to ensure 100% Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) across all Households.

JAL JEEVAN MISSION CASE STUDY

Awareness and Capacity Building of Community









Water treatment Plant in Jamdiha, Churchu was established in 2019 with 906 household having regular supply of water.

Seema Devi beneficiary of Functional Household tap connection also a member of Maa Ambe SHG group stated that "Due to household tap connection she was relieved from worrying about water need for household choirs."

Bisu Kumar also stated that "keeping meals between family members was difficult during lockdown and at least they were able to have water because of Functional Household Tap Connection."

Including Jamdiha, 5 villages Khurandih, Nagri, Churchu, Bodra, Lasodh had regular supply of water till December 2022 when due to dysfunctional Electric Transformer in Water Treatment Plant they were unable to get water supply. With assent of beneficiaries and Mukhiya, beneficiaries have arranged a Gram Sabha to address this issue to Block level officials, due to lack of information about official steps beneficiaries weren't able to get the Transformer fix. With the proper guidance and assist by SUPPORT Community Mobilizers Parvachan Kumar Bharti and Sahzada Usman Khalique, beneficiaries arranged another Gram Sabha in which they have proposed a request to governmental officials to provide new transformer. Resultantly, New Transformer was installed, and supply of water restarted.

With the proper guidance and handholding support by the SUPPORT employees Jamdiha with 5 other villages have regular supply of Water from the Functional Household Tap Connection. The mobilizers also encourage to deposit the collection money and water tariff for the issue to fix.

E-SHAKTI: DIGITISATION OF SHG



E-Shakti is an initiative of Micro Credit Innovations Department NABARD in lines with our Hon'ble PM's statement, 'we move with the dream of electronic digital India...'. Digital India is a Rs 1.13L-crore initiative of the Government of India: to the integrate government departments with the people of India and to ensure effective governance. The program is to "transform India" into digital empowered society and knowledge economy".

Insight of the Government of India's mission for creating a digital India, NABARD launched a project for digitisation of all Self- Help Group (SHG) in the country. The project is being implemented in 100 districts across the country.

Objectives

- Digitisation of all the SHG accounts to bring SHG members under the fold of Financial Inclusion.
- Providing them access to wider range of financial services together with increasing the bankers' comfort in credit appraisal and linkage by way of:
 - Integrating SHG members with the national Financial Inclusion agenda.
 - Improving the quality of the interface between SHG members and Banks for efficient hassle-free delivery banking services by using the available technology.
 - Facilitate convergence of delivery system with SHGs using Aadhaar linked identity.



VLP(VILLAGE LEVEL PROGRAMME)

In sight to foster better understanding of mutual requirements between banks, SHGs& SHPIs also to sort out issues like credit linkage & repayment etc. at ground level; Village Level Programmes (VLPs) are being implemented with the support of banks and NRLM. These VLPs sponsored by NABARD, are also helping in accounts opening of SHGs, their credit linkage, and regular repayments.



The project has enabled the Bankers for providing online credit to SHGs based on an inbuilt grading system.

TDF WADI CHURCHU PROJECT -I & II

Based on the successful experience of Tribal Development Programmes, NABARD embarked upon an ambitious program of replicating the WADI model across the country. In this direction, NABARD created a Tribal Development Fund (TDF) to promote sustainable participatory livelihood program which inter alia, aims at economic upliftment through sustainable agriculture, social empowerment, improvement in quality of life including health and women development, in tribal predominant areas of the country through demonstration projects. The objective of this Fund is to create replicable models of integrated development of tribal families on a participatory basis, through the adoption of sustainable incomegenerating activities and to build and strengthen tribal institutions which enable mainstreaming of the communities by improving their socio-economic status. Over the years supporting the tribal communities with WADI, as the core component has been the focus area of the TDF program.

SUPPORT is implementing 2 TDF WADI projects in the Churchu block of Hazaribag district. The program intends to take up horticulture development activities on 1000 Acres including Soil & Moisture conservation activities, water resource development, supporting the landless families, promotion of kitchen gardens, input and marketing support through FPO, etc. A summary of activities taken up in the current financial year and cumulative statistics are provided below:

HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

INTRODUCTION

Under HRDP (Holistic Rural Development Program) supported by HDFC bank under the Parivartan initiative implemented by SUPPORT, 15 villages in the Chandwara block of Koderma district are witnessing a positive change in their existence.

SOCIO-ECONOMIC STATUS

The 15 villages has a greater number of daily wage labours and low-income families. The women are gradually getting exposure to breaking hesitation and involve in outside work. The villages have a mixed socio-economic condition. The village-level education status follows under moderate; the young age groups of the fellows are now getting a good education but due to covid out break temporary school drop outs increased. The old age people are illiterate.

HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME CASE STUDY

Encouraging Girl Child Education with proper Sanitation Facility



Miss Priyanshu Kumari is a student in Grade 9 of Jongi High School in Jongi village, Koderma District. 15-year-old Priyanshu Kumari lives with her family.Her father is a farmer(the only bread earner).

As part of the Holistic Rural Development Programme, SUPPORT in collaboration with HDFC Bank established Integrated Smart School Digital Learning System. While working on this initiative, the field worker experienced that the dropout rate of girl students was noticeably high due to improper sanitation and cleanliness.

When the SUPPORT team talked to Priyanshu Kumari, she said that the school had separate toilets for boy and girl students. But most of the time, the toilet was full of waste, making it impossible for her to use the toilet. Due to this reason, she was compelled to miss school on some days.

After discussing with her, the SUPPORT team realised this problem is the biggest issue for adolescent students, particularly girls. In February 2022, During the establishment of the Integrated Smart School, SUPPORT members supervised the cleaning of the toilets and made students aware of the maintenance of cleanliness in the toilets. Now students, especially girls, are not missing their school due to the unsanitary conditions of the toilets. They also praised the initiative of HDFC Bank for bringing their smiles back.

HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME CASE STUDY

Capacity Building of poor habitants towards Entrepreneurship Development



Mr. Ramji yadav, a 40 Year old Migrant labour lives in a joint family consisting of 15 members in Mahuadaha Village, Situated under Bhondo Panchayat, Chandwara Block in Koderma District in Jharkhand. He worked as a driver in Rajasthan for many year. His Monthly income varied between 20-25 thousand per month. After a reduction of his expenses, he could save very little for the family. Sometimes his salary also get delayed for 3-5 months leading to the financial crisis.

During the nation wide lock down Mr. Ramji Yadav Lost his job. Later he decided to work as a farmer. mr. Ramji owns 4 acres of land out of which half if his land is situated in the jungle that he could not utilise because of animal terror. In the remaining 2 acres of land, he started farming but sue to lack of awareness and knowledge, he could not utilise his land properly.

In January 2022 the SUPPORT staff after observing his problem offered him to establish farmer field school on his land. After regular visits and training from SUPPORT, he fenced his 4 acres of land and started farming watermelon, sweet corn, tomato, onion, bitter gourd, lady Finger, coriander, chickpea, etc. His Wife Mrs, Draupadi Devi also put of effort to make it successful.

Mr. Ramji Yadav feels very pleased with the outcome of his farming. He shared that, other villagers appreciated his farming skills and knowledge for proper utilisation of his head. he wants to thank the Holistic Rural Development Programme run by HDFC Bank Ltd. CSR initiative 'PARIVARTAN' and 'SUPPORT' members for the source of Income from agriculture by enhancing his farming skills.

ENABLING SAFE PUBLIC PLACE AND ENHANCING INCOME AND MITIGATING COVID

Ford Foundation in collaboration with SUPPORT organised capacity building program in Jagannathpur and Noamundi block of West Singhbhum district with the objective to "Enable Safe Public Spaces, Enhances Income and Mitigate Covid for Women Farmer and Agricultural worker in Jharkhand India"

The capacity-building training was provided at the block and village level to the CSOs and PRI members. It focused on Community mobilisation of SHG, VO, CLF, and MGNREGA Labours by Organising Rojgar diwas and Community strengthening training by Gender block coordinator and Gender Integrator. It tried to cater towards multiple aspects by considering how MGNERGA can be the solution to eradicate poverty and tool for sustainable development, equal wages for female labour, participation by community in decision making, and assuring the safe working environment.

WATERSHED DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Under NABARD's Watershed Development Fund Program, SUPPORT is implementing Watershed projects in Petarbar block of Bokaro district. The project through its diverse interventions focuses on rainwater harvesting and recharge of groundwater table, reducing soil erosion through LBS, Nala Bund, and Farm Bunding, minimising migration and generating wage employment and livelihood, and raising the standard of living of rural poor through credit and grants, promoting incremental agricultural production and productivity, conserving and managing natural resources, climate change adaptation, and mitigation, capacity building of stakeholder to rehabilitate, creation of quality structures and assets, increase agriculture land and developing community ownership in the project area

OBJECTIVES

The main objective of watershed management is to conserve the soil, plant, and water resources of a catchment while benefiting humanity. All environmental, social, and economic concerns are combined to treat watersheds in an integrated manner embodying:

- Improvement and restoration of soil quality and thus raising productivity rates of crops.
- To minimise the risk of floods, droughts, and landslide
- To improve and increase the production of timbers, fodders, and wildlife resources
- To enhance the groundwater recharge.

KOH WATERSHED PROGRAM



Success story of Koh Jalchhajan -Peterwar

This is the story of a farmer, Gopichand Murmu, who earlier used to cultivate only 3 acres of paddy and 1-1.5 acres of some rain-based vegetables out of his 10 acres due to lack of water and that to only having food for few months. He used to live in the village and then after finishing farming, he used to migrate out of the village to earn money.

Under Koh watershed of NABARD, his farm has been fenced and next to his field, two dobhas one 50 * 50 * 10 and one 80 * 60 * 10 have been made. Today he is cultivating bitter gourd, cucumber, gourd, tomato, brinjal, and okra in about 1 acres of land, and is cultivating paddy on 2 acres, Due to which his annual income has been around two lakhs. From that income, 1 acre of land is being used for drip irrigation.

Today he is teaching his children in a good school. He says that if a program like Watershed had come earlier, then we would have been able to educate our elder child well and feed well. He provides financial help to the people of the village. He also bought an auto rickshaw with his earnings and transports his produce to the markets. Today he does not go outside to earn but does farming in the village itself and then for work in the watershed project. he is spending his life happily.

SUSTAIN PLUS

SUPPORT in collaboration with CInI – Tata Trusts have launched the five years Mission programme Lakhpati Kisan Smart Village in Churchu and Dadi blocks of Hazaribagh district in the Jharkhand state. This initiative is expected to develop this region as a driver for growth in adjoining areas and be a part of vibrant self-reliant community institutions.

CORE FOCUS

By the end of Lakhpati Kisan Mission program, Churchu block will become an Incubation Hub for doorstep service delivery system. Through 51 different rural entrepreneurs of Lakhpati Kisan program, Churchu and Dadi Blocks will be able bring a positive transformation in the life style of rural farmers through strong community institutions. The overall impact of this program interprets 5200 HHs engaged in livelihood activities. From which 1508 HHs have become Lakhpati ensuring an annual income up to Rs 1,20,000/- by engagement n single or multiple livelihoods layering activities. Later, it will bring reinforcements for irreversible and sustainable irrigation facilities provided to each of the Lakhpati Households with min. 30 decimal Land. In which the farmers can cultivate HVC (High-Value Crops) through the year . By receiving capacity-building trainings and exposures, farmers can Produce more yields by practicing scientific methods. The overall impact of this mission can be seen in terms of quality of life and standard of living of Lakhpati Farmers.

SUSTAIN PLUS CASE STUDY





Sughanlal Soren resident of village Chanaro, Tola - Parbaad, Panchayat - Chanaro , Block - Churchu , District - Hazaribagh is one of the emerging pig entrepreneur in Churchu PIP. He is also actively working as Livestock Service Provider.

Livestock has ever remained his major source of income generation. Before the implementation of Piggery in his village, he owned 2 Ox. Once, the health of one of the Ox was not good for which the veterinary doctor has charged a very huge amount. On that very day he decided to become Livestock Service Provider, so that he could serve his own livestock as well as serve the livestock of the villagers.

In the year 2015, he is appointed as LSP (Livestock Service Provider) and gave his valuable services to the livestock farmers continuously for five years. He himself owns 2 Ox, 5 Pigs and 1 Buck but this was also not enough for him. To widespread his livelihood generation he became an active pig entrepreneur of his village. Under Sustain Plus, Solar Vaccination Chamber was installed at his home premises where cold chain can be maintained for vaccines for continuous hours.

The total HHs benefited from this Livestock Chamber is 102 with 510 members. The vaccination chamber was installed in the month of August 2020 and was inaugurated by Honour Deputy Development Commissioner of Hazaribagh Shri Abhay Kumar Sinha. Sughan Lal himself took the initiative to construct the base of Vaccination Chamber and responsibility of its maintenance and provides timely services to the nearby households. Since he is actively working as Livestock Service Provider as well as Pig Entrepreneur, the installation of Solar Vaccination Chamber had benefitted him a lot towards vaccines cold chain maintenance and an opportunity of earning on a sustainable model. In the continuous scenario of pandemic, this Vaccination Chamber is imparting timely vaccines and providing safety to the livestock of nearby Households.

Lac cultivation is one of the most essential prototype in this program which has significantly enhanced the income level of the farmers as well as the number of interested farmers.
